- Friday, May 17, 2024, at 9:00 A.M.
- Friday, June 21, 2024, at 9:00 A.M.
- Friday, July 19, 2024, at 9:00 A.M.
- Friday, August 16, 2024, at 9:00 A.M.

## \*PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR SUMMONS AND A PICTURE ID ON March 15, 2024\*

**PARKING**: The Courthouse is located at 55 School Street in Lancaster, New Hampshire. Parking is available in the public parking lot located on the left side of the building. Handicapped parking is located in front of the building near the main entrance. Jurors appearing for grand jury service should enter the building through the main entrance. The Superior Court is located on the third floor of the building.
