INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILING A REQUEST FOR EXCEPTION FROM ELECTRONIC FILING

Electronic filing is **mandatory** in certain Superior Court Civil cases. Under limited circumstances, the court may grant a request to be excused. See the NH Superior Court E-Filing Rule 1(b)(1). Extraordinary Circumstances: The Electronic Filing Rules allow you to request an exception, and if granted, to be excused from electronic filing if:

- 1. A party is protected by law from disclosing certain identifying or contact information.
- 2. Extraordinary circumstances would render electronic filing such a hardship that you would be denied access to the court.

Every circumstance is different but generally, this exception is reserved for extreme situations (Note: If you do not have a computer at home, there are computers available in every court lobby so that alone does not rise to the level of an extraordinary circumstance.

To make this request:

- 1. Complete the case related documents that you are filing (i.e. Complaint, Motion, Objection)
- Complete the Motion for Exception from Electronic Filing Due to Extraordinary Circumstances (NHJB- 4019-Se)
- 3. Hand Deliver or Mail the documents and filing fee (if applicable) to the Superior Court where you are filing your case. All Superior Court locations can be found at: https://www.courts.state.nh.us/courtlocations/index.htm#superior
- 4. You must send a copy of these documents to any party already involved in the case.

What happens next?

The court will rule on your request. You will receive the ruling and further instructions by U.S. Mail.
