**MBE SCORE TRANSFER AND SCORE ADVISORY REQUEST FORM**

The New Hampshire Board of Bar Examiners offers two score reporting services: (1) transfer of an applicant's raw and scaled MBE score from New Hampshire directly to another jurisdiction (including concurrent administration) and (2) informing an applicant whether the MBE score previously earned in New Hampshire meets the requirements for admission in another jurisdiction. New Hampshire will not release directly to an applicant the precise MBE score achieved in New Hampshire. For the specific MBE score requirements of other jurisdictions, you must contact those jurisdictions directly. There is a \$25.00 fee for each jurisdiction to which the score will be reported and a \$25.00 fee for each score advisory. Payment by check or money order made payable to the New Hampshire Board of Bar Examiners must be included with the request form.
