I find that the rule substantially increases the cost of summary judgment pleadings. If the Superior Court bench thinks it is helpful, that is fine; otherwise I would scrap it. Generally, I think you wind up with two statements of fact with responses; and I'm not sure how helpful that is to determine whether there are triable issues.
