WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOU FILE
A MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

You will receive an e-mail from the court (no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud) when your Motion for Summary Judgment has been accepted.

IMPORTANT: For the rest of your case, you will receive important case related emails from either NHCourtsNo-Reply@turbocourt.com or no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud so be sure to add BOTH to your address book and to your approved email list. Failure to do so may result in you missing court orders and important information about your case.

When you file a Motion for Summary Judgment, the other party has 30 days to respond to it. In most cases a response to a motion is required within 10 days but because Motions for Summary Judgment generally involve more than just a motion (a Motion for Summary Judgment may include affidavits, interrogatory answers, depositions, etc.) the party against whom the Motion for Summary Judgment has been filed is given 30 days to respond. That party may include their own affidavits, interrogatory answers, depositions, etc. to supplement their objection.

In reviewing the Motion for Summary Judgment, the Court must find that, based upon the motion and attachments, that there is no genuine issue of material fact for the Court to decide and that the filer of the motion is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. The Court may issue an Order based upon the filings or may set the case for a hearing on the motion.

Viewing Your Case Online

At any time you may access your electronically filed documents through our Case Access Portal by going to the court's website at www.courts.state.nh.us and selecting the Electronic Services icon on the upper right hand side of the page. Next, select e-File /Resource/Case Access Information HERE or use <https://odypa.nhecourt.us/portal> and follow the instructions in the User Guide. In that process you will register, validate your email, request access and approval to view your case. After your information is validated by the court, you will be able to view case information and documents filed in your case.
