WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOU FILE  
AN OBJECTION TO A MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

You will receive an e-mail from the court ([no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud](mailto:no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud)) when your Objection to a Motion for Summary Judgment has been accepted.

IMPORTANT: For the rest of your case, you will receive important case related emails from either [NHCourtsNo-Reply@turbocourt.com](mailto:NHCourtsNo-Reply@turbocourt.com) or [no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud](mailto:no-reply@efilingmail.tylertech.cloud) so be sure to add BOTH to your address book and to your approved email list. Failure to do so may result in you missing court orders and important information about your case.

When you file an Objection to a Motion for Summary Judgment, the other party may or may not respond to it. When filing an Objection to a Motion for Summary Judgment, you should include attachments such as affidavits, answers to interrogatory questions, etc. which bolster your objection.

In reviewing the Motion for Summary Judgment, the Court must determine, based upon the motion and your response, whether there is any genuine issue of material fact for the Court to decide and whether the filer of the motion is entitled to judgment as a matter of law. The Court may issue an Order based upon the filings or may set the case for a hearing on the motion.

Viewing Your Case Online

At any time you may access your electronically filed documents through our Case Access Portal by going to the court's website at [www.courts.state.nh.us](http://www.courts.state.nh.us) and selecting the Electronic Services icon on the upper right hand side of the page. Next, select e-File /Resource/Case Access Information HERE or use <https://odypa.nhecourt.us/portal> and follow the instructions in the User Guide. In that process you will register, validate your email, request access and approval to view your case. After your information is validated by the court, you will be able to view case information and documents filed in your case.
