**REQUEST FOR COURT-APPOINTED COUNSEL IN  
EXPEDITED CONFIDENTIAL APPEAL FROM LOWER COURT DECISION ON  
PARENTAL NOTIFICATION PRIOR TO ABORTION**

This form should be used only by a pregnant minor who intends to appeal a denial of a Petition for Waiver of Parental Notice for Abortion Requested by a Minor pursuant to RSA 132:34, and who was not represented by counsel in the Superior Court but who wishes to be represented in the Supreme Court by court-appointed counsel.

This form must be filled out completely. You may file the form with the Superior Court during normal business hours of the court, or send it by first class mail addressed to the clerk of the Superior Court. You may also file the form by sending it to the following e-mail address:
