As per Supreme Court Rule 48-B (7), a divorce/parenting mediator may have their mileage reimbursed for the first mediation session of a case. You must submit your mileage log *within 45 days* of the first mediation session. For the time being, please **MAIL** mileage reimbursement requests to the Office of Mediation and Arbitration.

Rule 32 Mediator Recertification Reminder

Thank you to those who have submitted your recertification documentation already. Please note that documentation of the annual eight hour refresher training requirement to maintain eligibility for 2023 is due for Superior Court neutrals. Please submit the required documentation as soon as possible.

Follow up to the S. Ct. Rule 48-B Focus Group

Thank you to those who attended the divorce/parenting mediator focus group regarding the potential revisions to Supreme Court Rule 48-B. Given the feedback that was received, the ADR Office will prioritize increasing mediation fees for the initial rule change request.
