Case Type	Prior Payment Amount	Payment as of 8/1/22
TPR/VMA	\$350 for 12 hours	\$480 for 8 hours
Guardianship of the Incapacitated	\$350 for 12 hours	\$480 for 8 hours
Minor Guardianship	\$350 for 12 hours	\$480 for 8 hours
Trusts/Estates/Equity	\$350 for 12 hours	\$480 for 8 hours
Complex Cases	\$500 for 7 hours, \$60 per hour above 7 hours	\$500 for 5 hours, \$100 per hour above 5 hours
