INSTRUCTIONS FOR GRAND JURORS
March 2022 to August 2022

JURY SERVICE: You may log in to e-response at www.courts.state.nh.us/jury by using your Candidate ID and PIN to view your schedule.

If your first date of grand jury service is **Friday, March 18, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**, you must also report on the following dates:

- **Friday, April 15, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**
- **Friday, May 20, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**
- **Friday, June 17, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**
- **Friday, July 15, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**
- **Friday, August 19, 2022, at 9:00 A.M.**

PLEASE REMEMBER TO BRING YOUR SUMMONS AND A PICTURE ID ON March 18, 2022

The Superior Court has a policy on how jurors should dress for Court. The policy prohibits the wearing of torn clothing, cut-offs, shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, clothing with slogans or written expressions, or any other dress which the Court may determine to be inappropriate. **Please be advised that facial coverings are required while serving as a juror.**

PARKING: The Courthouse is located at 55 School Street in Lancaster, New Hampshire. Parking is available in the public parking lot located on the left side of the building. Handicapped parking is located in front of the building near the main entrance. Jurors appearing for grand jury service should enter the building through the main entrance. The Superior Court is located on the third floor of the building.

SECURITY: The Courthouse is a secure environment. Every person entering the Courthouse must pass through the metal detector.

LUNCH: Jurors are on their own for lunch. Coffee is provided.

ATTENDANCE: After the completion of each date of service, court staff will provide you with attendance verification, if required by your employer.

CONTACT: Be sure you list your current e-mail address and/or cellphone number in your online questionnaire so we can notify you of any changes in your service. If you have any questions, please call 1-855-212-1234, option 4 and ask to be transferred to the Jury Center.
