PETIT JURY SERVICE

You have been selected to serve as a Petit Juror for the Merrimack County Superior Court. Your service will be limited to one trial only which is expected to go seven to eight weeks beginning September 12, 2022 through November 10, 2022. For purposes of your contact with the Court, please note that you will be referred to as a member of the Special Panel.

YOU MUST REPORT TO THE COURTHOUSE ON

September 7, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. for jury selection

PLEASE BRING YOUR SUMMONS AND A PHOTO ID WHEN REPORTING

Please note that the Superior Court has a policy on how jurors should dress for Court. The policy prohibits the wearing of torn clothing, cut-offs, shorts, tank tops, t-shirts, clothing with slogans or written expressions, or any other dress which the Court may determine to be inappropriate. In addition, please be advised that it is a class B felony to carry a firearm or other deadly weapon as defined in RSA 625:11,V in a courtroom or area used by a court. Please be advised that facial coverings are required while serving as a Juror.

SECURITY: The Courthouse is a secure environment. Every person entering the Courthouse must pass through the metal detector. Please check our web page <https://www.courts.nh.gov/> for further information. The following items are not permitted in the courthouse: cigarette lighters, key lanyards, guns, knives, OC/pepper spray, D-rings, scissors and knitting needles.

LUNCH: Jurors are on their own for lunch; however, lunch will be provided for deliberating panels. You may bring bottled water with you but no other beverages or food is allowed in the courthouse.

ATTENDANCE: Certification of your attendance, if required by your employer, is available from the Clerk's Office.

CONTACT: Be sure you list a current telephone number AND e-mail address in your online questionnaire so we can notify you of any changes in your service. If you have any questions please call 1-855-212-1234, option 4 and ask to be transferred to the Jury Center.
