

MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 22, 2022
VIRTUAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TASK FORCE

The Domestic Violence Task Force met virtually on Tuesday, February 22, 2022, with the meeting called to order by Justice Hantz Marconi at 4:00 p.m.

Justice Hantz Marconi referenced a draft Report of the Domestic Violence Task Force that was circulated to members on Friday, February 18, for feedback and edits. She thanked members for their hard work during the process, and thanked the working group for determining where suggestions fit within the Report.

She explained that the purpose of the meeting is answer outstanding questions, identify remaining concerns, and wrap up the report in order to send out another draft for review before sending it to the Supreme Court.

Final thoughts included:

- **What are other states doing?**
- **Transparency.**
- **Improve accessibility of system.**
- **Judge training.**
- **Improve communication among stakeholders.**
- **Hopeful that recommendations will provide a path forward for criminal justice stakeholders and legislative leaders.**
- **Data collection is vital.**
 - **Costs to input and collect data.**
- **Press conference once Report is final.**
